Zach Skow, Founder of Marley's Mutts® and Co-Founder of the Pawsitive Change® Program is a visionary. When he was diagnosed with end-state liver disease resulting from years of alcohol and drug abuse, his dog Marley helped pull him out of depression with unconditional love. This prompted Zach to start the dog rescue in 2009. Marley's Mutts received 501(c)(3) status in 2010.



Marley's Mutts Dog Rescue® is a non-profit dedicated to saving at-risk shelter dogs in Kern, Los Angeles and other counties. With euthanasia often the only solution to control the population in overcrowded county shelters, our skilled Ranch Advocates and army of Mutt Militia volunteers work to get dogs off the euthanasia list, modify behaviors if necessary, and provide a nurturing and rehabilitative environment to facilitate a magical transformation into a loving adoptive home.

To combat this national euthanasia epidemic, Marley's Mutts expanded it efforts geographically beyond Kern County into Los Angeles and surrounding counties, and from a rescue-only focus to innovative, scalable community programs including Miracle Mutts® Pawsitive Change® & Mutt Movers.



COMMUNITY PROGRAMS



Miracle Mutts® uses the powerful properties of the canine/human connection to bring about healing to many vulnerable and underserved members of the community. This program is administered by one Marley's employee and dozens of dedicated volunteer handlers who earn AKC Certified Therapy Dogs credentials


Pawsitive Change® is an innovative and comprehensive 16-week vocational training program that pairs dogs from high-kill shelters with incarcerated male, female and juvenile students for mutual rehabilitation. All work toward Canine Good Citizen training and Certificate of Completion.





Mutt Movers-No single rescue can help save every homeless dog in their community. Mutt Movers saves dogs from high-kill shelters and transports to rescue partners in other US States and Canada who have space and a shortage of adoptable dogs.

Our Pawsitive Change Program partnership with **Hounds & Heroes** allows us to identify companion dogs and adopt them with no fees to a veteran.
